(ALLIGATOR MISSISSIPIENSIS)

Your picture was taken with ________, who lives here at Colorado Gators. Most of the gators you see here are rescued or confiscated pets that have come from Colorado, New Mexico, and even as far away as New York and Alaska! Most of the other animals you see here including pythons, boas, rattlesnakes, turtles, tortoises, lizards, parrots, emus, and even the cats are rescues. Many of these animals have come from un-informed pet owners who did not know what they were getting into, while others were illegal to own as a pet and were there for confiscated and brought to us. Colorado Gators displays these animals for educational purposes.

The American Alligator normally inhabits swamps in the socth-eastern U.S. The alligators at Colorado Gators survive the harsh winters outdoors with the help of a geothermal well (heated by the earth) which produces 87 F (30.5 C) water year round. This water also heats the fish tanks of the tilapia farm and helps heat the reptile building.
