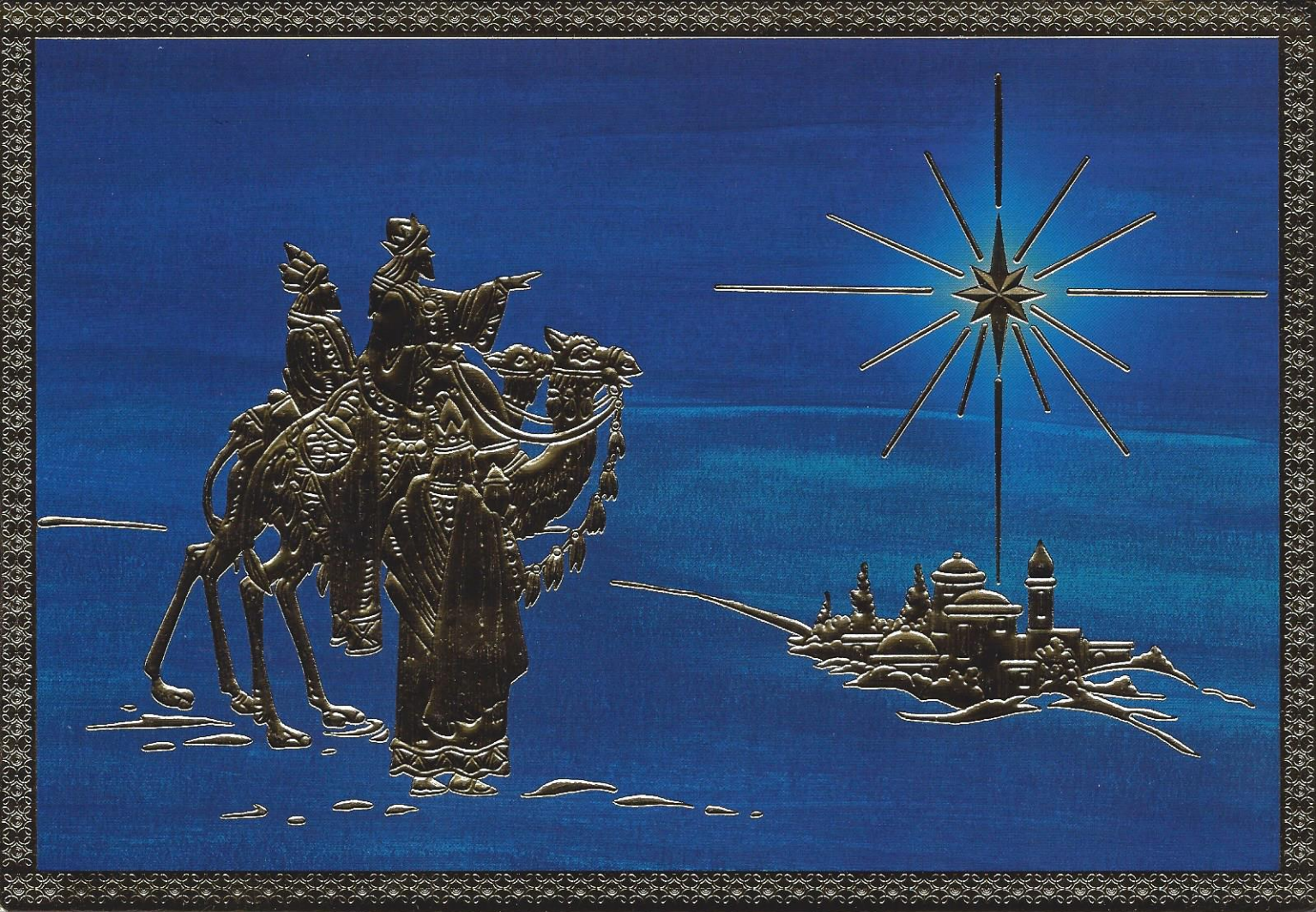

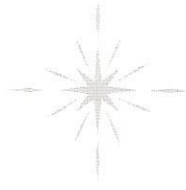
That's been our year. We both hope your 2015 will be full of family, happiness, joy, and lots of fun. **Remember,**
