

Merry Christmas everyone!!

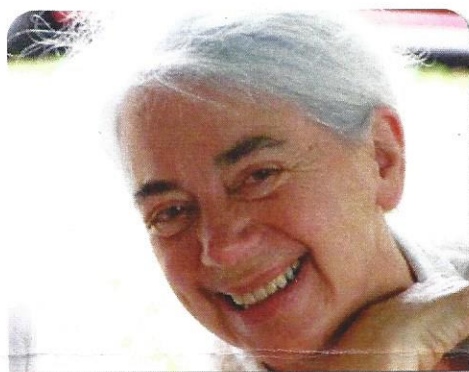
Dear Friends and Family,

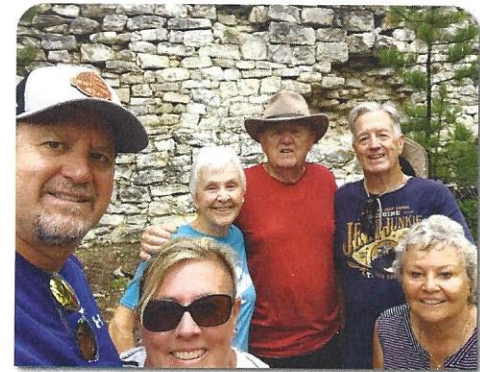
