Celebrating the Life of Richard A. Brin 1946 – 2024 It is with deep sadness we announce the passing of Richard “Rick” Alan Brin, 77, who peacefully departed life at his home in Montrose, CO, June 23, 2024, from complications of Alzheimer’s disease.

Rick was born October 6, 1946, in St. Lukes Hospital, Denver, CO, to Alverize John Brin and Exzlina Florence Saindon. He attended school at Holy Family for primary grades and high school. He joined the Coast Guard in 1966 with time spent in San Francisco and areas around Alaska. After leaving the Coast Guard in 1970, Rick returned to Denver and went to work at Avaya, Inc., ultimately serving as Senior Manager of Business Operations and Systems. He retired after 39 years of service. His colleagues remember him for his integrity, generosity, and willingness to share his time and knowledge.
