REMEMBER ME IN YOUR HEART, YOUR THOUGHTS,

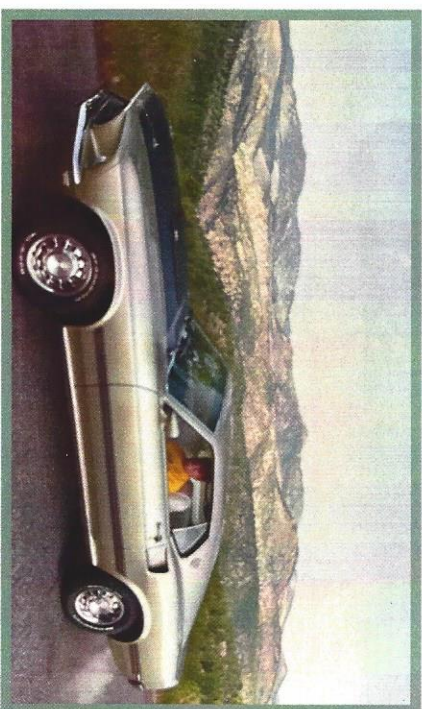
YOUR MEMORIES OF THE TIMES WE LOVED,
