the street becomes Alamo. Continue on Alamo 3 blocks to  
Prince Street. Turn right (south) and go about 6 blocks to  
Prince Street. Turn right at the main gate onto Rose Lane  
and continue to the last crossroad and turn left. Go past  
the trees and Jerry's memorial site is on the left.
